NOTIFICATION

This notification is in compliance with the Memo No.10-Secy/11099/41/2023-ADMN SEC-DSE, dated 27/05/24 of School Education Department, Government of West Bengal for all the recognized schools under the academic/administrative jurisdiction of West Bengal Board of Secondary Education except for those schools located in the hill areas of Darjeeling and Kalimpong, being notified the following regarding reopening of schools after summer vacation:

- A) Teaching, and non-teaching staff of all State aided/sponsored / Government schools are advised to attend school, from 3rd June, 2024, subject to the directions issued by the Concerned Election Authorities, as the case may be, due to ensuing Parliament General Elections 2024, to ensure the suitable school infrastructure is in place, with the appropriate assistance of the District Magistrates/Commissioner Kolkata Municipal Corporation, as the case may be, before the schools are opened for students. It is expected that the above arrangement, will be completed by 09/06/2024.
- B) The State aided/Sponsored/ Government schools may be opened for students from 10/06/2024 onwards.

As per notification no.590-SED/Admin, dated 18th April 2024 issued by School Education Department, Government of West Bengal subsequent to re-opening of schools, the teaching/non-teaching staff of schools shall make suitable arrangements, appropriate to the institution, in the interest of the students, for conducting extra classes to offset the losses of classes due to preponement of summer vacation.

All Head of the Institutions of schools are requested to take necessary action accordingly.
