NOTIFICATION

Subject: Final and last Phase for Online Registration of Class IX (2024) with late submission fees

This is furtherance to our previous notification: DS(C)/094/24, DS(C)/107/24, DS(C)/117/24 and DS(C)/008/25 Dated 11.07.2024, 31.08.2024, 19.09.2024 and 14.01.2025 respectively regarding the online Registration of Class IX (2024), which concluded on 31.08.2024 (First Phase), 15.09.2024 (Second Phase), 30.09.2024 (Third Phase) and 16.01.2025 (Forth Phase), it is noted that mostly 9,326 schools have successfully completed their online Registration process for Class IX (2024). 1079305 candidates have already received their Registration Certificates in the month of December, 2024. Few more who availed the option given in the fourth phase have also received their Registration Certificates by January, 2025.

However, the Board after being informed about few pending cases of registration in the students' interest has decided to offer a special window, by keeping the Online Registration portal open for the students who failed to complete their Registration through their respective schools.

The portal will be accessible for *from 11:00 AM on 28th June, 2025, to 11:00 AM 5th July, 2025*. This extended window is specifically for students who missed the initial deadline. Please note that a **late fee as admissible** will be applicable for all such cases during this period.

No cases of Registration of Class IX (2024) will be admissible after completion of this period. Accountability and liability of any non-registration of any valid candidate (Candidates who has progressed to higher class successfully, has taken admission in higher class, received text book from school and paid the fees to the school) subsequent to the given deadlines above shall be with the school authority in all such cases being reported to the Board.

Instructions for Schools:

- 1. Schools are directed to complete the Registration process for any remaining such students within the specified time frame to avoid further hardship for such students.
- 2. Hard copies of the authenticated Registration Data (submitted online) along with any required supporting documents shall have to be submitted to the concerned Regional Office for at the earliest for verification and record-keeping.

It is earnestly hoped that cooperation from all concerned will be available in the interest of the students.
