**Sub: Mandatory Attendance at schools on 13<sup>th</sup> March, 2026 (Friday)**

The undersigned is directed to notify all concerned that in compliance to order No. 968-F(P2) , dated 12/03/2026 , issued by Finance (Audit) Department, Govt. of West Bengal, all state government offices including those provided with Grants – in – Aid by the State Government shall remain open and all the employees shall report for duty on that day. It has been decided that no Casual Leave or any other Leave for absence either in the 1<sup>st</sup> half or in the 2<sup>nd</sup> half or for the whole day shall be granted to any employee on the above mentioned day, apart from the circumstances of exception mentioned in the above-stated Memo.

As per the order referred above, all Heads of Institutions / D.I. (S.E.) of the concerned districts (as the case may be) will not admit salary for the day/date, and issue showcause notice to the employee(s) in such schools who will remain absent on 13<sup>th</sup> March, 2026 (Friday). In the showcause Notice they are to be asked to explain why actions would not be taken against him/her for such unauthorized absence. All course of action in terms of this order should be completed by 30<sup>th</sup> March, 2026.

All the Heads of Recognised Secondary Schools under W.B.B.S.E. provided with Grant – in – Aid – and D.I.s (S.E.) are hereby requested to forward the names of those employees who have not responded to the show-cause notice or have found their response not satisfactory, then the same to be reported to the respective Regional Officers of the Board, and disciplinary action will be taken against the concerned employees, accordingly by appropriate authority.

**MEMORANDUM**

In view of call given by some organisations for strike on the 13<sup>th</sup> March, 2026 (Friday) it has been decided that all State Government Offices including those provided with Grants-in-Aid by the State Government shall remain open as usual and all the employees shall report for duty on that day. It has been decided that no Casual Leave or any other leave for absence either in the 1st half or in the 2nd half or for the whole day shall be granted to any employee on the above-mentioned day.

It is further notified that absence of employees on that day will be treated as '*dies-non*' and no salary will be admissible unless such absence is covered by any of the following grounds:

- a) Hospitalisation of the employees;
- b) Bereavement in the family;
- c) Severe illness and absence continuing prior to 12<sup>th</sup> March, 2026;
- d) Employees who had been on Child Care Leave, Maternity Leave, Medical Leave and Earned Leave sanctioned prior to 12<sup>th</sup> March, 2026.

All Heads of Offices/Controlling Authorities concerned will issue Show-Cause notice to the employee(s) concerned, who will remain absent on the 13<sup>th</sup> March, 2026 (Friday), asking him/her to explain why action would not be taken against him/her for such unauthorized absence. On receipt of satisfactory reply, leave due and admissible may be granted on production of documentary evidence on the grounds mentioned above. Where the absence is not covered by any of the above-mentioned reasons and the leave has not been approved, the same will be treated as '*dies-non*' and no salary will be admissible for the above-mentioned day. Those who will not respond to the Show-Cause notice will be liable to disciplinary action.

All course of action in terms of this order should be completed by 30<sup>th</sup> March, 2026(Monday) and compliance report on action taken should be sent to this Department.




